CLP Joins Hands with the Community to Beautify Substation

CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (CLP Power) has launched a Substation Beautification Project to connect people with community through art and creativity, encouraging them to create a greener and more sustainable future together. CLP Power Chief Corporate Development Officer Ms Quince Chong, District Officer (Kwun Tong) Mr Andy Lam Siu-hong, and Chairman of Kwun Tong CLP Local Customer Advisory Committee Mr Wilson Yip Hing-kwok joined volunteers from CLP Power and collaborating partner, as well as ethnic minority children and parents to paint murals on a substation in No. 67, Hung To Road, Kwun Tong on 7 January, adding a splash of colour to the neighbourhood while promoting energy conservation and decarbonisation.

CLP Power teamed up with the non-profit making art group Paint Beautiful Hong Kong to create the murals featuring local landmarks and culture and green energy on the Kwun Tong substation. Initiated in June last year, the project took half a year to complete with joint efforts and participation from more than 60 volunteers, neighbours and community leaders.

Ms Chong said, 'The Substation Beautification Project aims to brighten up neighbourhoods that belong to everyone through art, with an emphasis on community participation. We hope that through these activities, the public can get to know their communities better, understand the importance of energy conservation and carbon reduction, and work together to protect the environment.'

The Kwun Tong substation was the second to be beautified under the project after the Haiphong Road substation in Tsim Sha Tsui, which was decorated with murals in August 2022. More substations in the CLP Power supply area are planned to be beautified later this year.
