

Join hands with the CLP Power Connect programme to save energy and help people in need, sending love and care across the community. CLP has set aside HK\$26 million this year to provide electricity subsidies to 40,000 underprivileged households, including HK\$500 each to single elderly people, elderly couples, people with disabilities, and low-income families. In addition, 10,000 households in subdivided units will receive subsidies of HK\$600 each. You can also take part by choosing the beneficiary group to be supported by the programme. Mr. Cheng, 92, and Mrs. Cheng, 88
Elderly couple
Public housing residents

Mr. Cheng suffers from hypertension, diabetes, and Parkinson's disease, and is taken care of by Mrs. Cheng. They rely on government subsidies to pay their rent, electricity, and daily expenses. Buying necessities takes up a large chunk of their monthly expenditure.



"We're old and have no income, so our daily expenses are a burden. My husband is bedridden and we need to use the air conditioner at home a lot, so I am very thankful for the electricity subsidies provided by CLP Power Connect. It reduces our expenses and leaves us with more money to pay for the things we need."

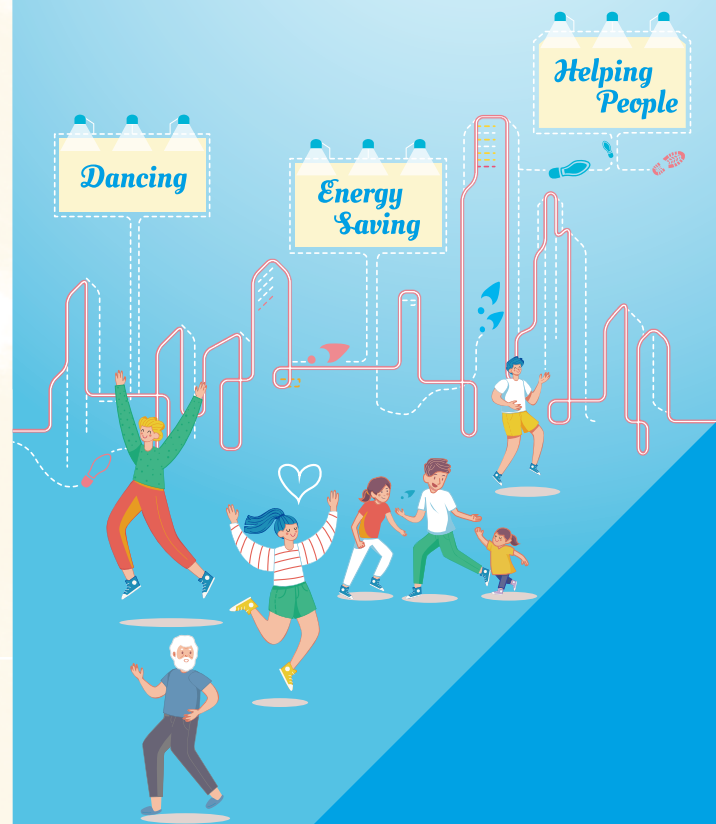

From now on, CLP Power organises a range of dancing activities in the community. 5 units of electricity will be given to the people in need through the CLP Power Connect programme for each dance completed by the participants, up to a maximum value of HK\$2 million.

Renowned Choreographer

The 120-second theme dance is choreographed by local renowned choreographer of a reality TV show Wong Cho-yiu, while the music was rearranged from the CLP 120th Anniversary theme song '120 years of shared vision' composed by young CLP engineer Sammy Wong.
