- Download the CLP App from the official app store (Google Play/ App Store), and log in to your CLP account using the CLP App. You can immediately validate your electricity bill, transaction records, and latest Domeo points record.
- 2.Turn on the eBill notification and payment alert in the CLP App. The eBill notification lets you know when your eBill has been sent; the payment alert reminds you to pay two days before your due date. By using the CLP App, you can protect yourself by identifying the genuine SMS from the bogus ones, which may give scammers access to your personal data.
- 3.To further enhance your account's security, set up a biometric login by completing the simple steps in the CLP App. Log in with your smartphone's Face ID or Touch ID for authentication instead of using long passwords.

Deciding between an induction cooker and an electric ceramic cooker can be simplified by asking yourself the following three questions:


1. Are you impatient for meal prep?

For example, unplug the appliances before mopping the floor around them. Place the appliances and extension boards properly to avoid electrical leakage and other safety hazards.

Unplug the refrigerator when cleaning or defrosting. Keep the towels in handy to soak up any excess water that may fall from the bottom tray onto other electronic equipment during defrosting.

You might experience a short circuit at home when (1) the circuit is overloaded, or (2) there is fault in the appliances. Therefore, large appliances such as washing machines, refrigerators, induction cookers or electric heaters require their independent sockets when in use.

If you experience a short circuit, be sure to locate the problem of the tripped breakers. Once you've made the repairs, you can turn the circuit breaker back on. However, if you experience a recurring short circuit, you must consult an electrician for repair.
