Energy-saving Tips

Summer's just about here, and the air conditioner is your buddy at home. But are there any tricks to use it efficiently?

Turn on the Fan Before Turning on the AC

The power consumption of running an AC for 1 hour is the same as running an electric fan for 20 hours. You can save 3% energy for every degree raised when the AC is running. So use electric fans to speed up cool air flow and thus faster cooling time even with higher AC temperatures.

AC's Fan Speed: the Higher, the Better?

Yes sure! Adjust the AC to a higher temperature, and set it on high fan speed. Try it out — it can keep your home at an ideal temperature and humidity level. It helps to lessen the burden of the compressor and save electricity.

The Cost of Frequently Turning the AC On and Off

Turning the AC on and off not only wastes electricity but also wears down your AC. The power consumption spikes at startup, so it's better to adjust the temperature rather than turning it off if you'll return soon.

AC's Dehumidifying Function and Electricity Usage

Many of you choose the AC's dehumidifying function for convenience, but it's a significant energy drain as the compressor continues to run. Spend smart, and in humid Hong Kong, investing in a dehumidifier is your practical option for moisture control.

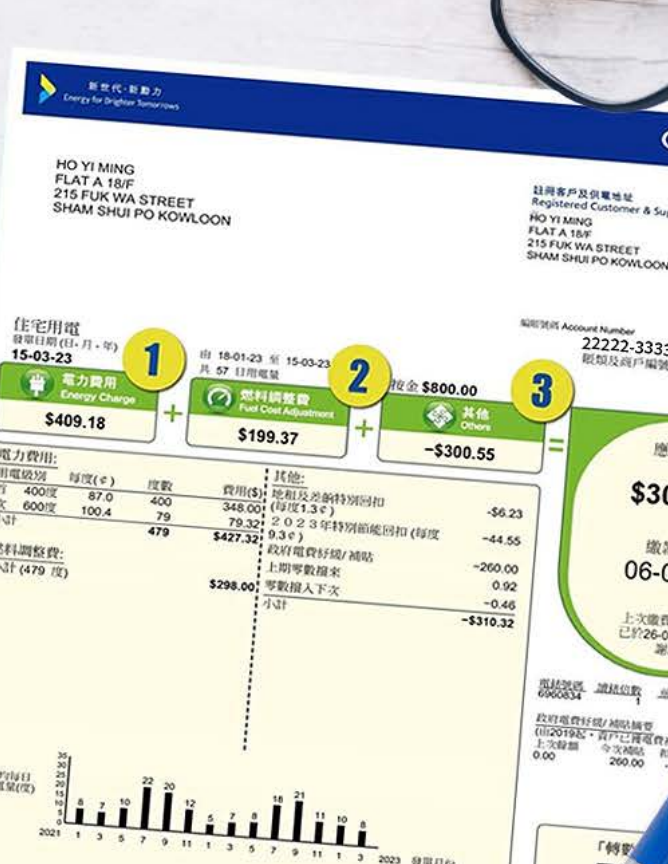
