Fact Sheet CLP Fuel Cost Subsidy Programme

Soaring international fuel prices and surge in the fuel cost for electricity generation have led to an increase of Fuel Cost Adjustment. To ease the burden on families in need, CLP Power is allocating HK\$100 million in 2023 to provide one-off fuel cost subsidies to 150,000 underprivileged households in its supply area.

- One-off fuel cost subsidies of HK\$600 will be provided to 100,000 households which are nominated by non-governmental organisations (NGOs) or community partners and receiving Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) or other Government assistance*. Beneficiaries will include single elderly people or elderly couples aged 65 years old or above, low-income families, and people with disabilities.
- One-off fuel cost subsidies of HK\$800 will be provided to 50,000 tenants of subdivided units (SDUs) nominated by NGOs or community partners.
- CLP Power will deposit the subsidies into the electricity accounts of beneficiaries and the bank accounts of tenants of SDUs.
- CLP Power will implement the subsidy programme in partnership with NGOs and community partners. Further details will be announced next year.

*Other Government assistance includes Old Age Living Allowance, Working Family Allowance Scheme, Full Grant of The School Textbook Assistance Scheme, Full Grant of Kindergarten and Child Care Centre Fee Remission Scheme, CSSA Scheme with Transport Supplement, Social Security Allowance Scheme with Disability Allowance, and holders of a Registration Card for People with Disabilities.
