

Join the Retro-Commissioning Charter Programme: Let's get ready for the green change



The CLP Community Energy Saving Fund has allocated HK\$1 million to launch the [CLP Retro-Commissioning Charter Programme](#), inviting business customers to join dedicated trainings for the energy efficiency of building, helping Hong Kong become a low-carbon smart city in the long run.

Buildings consume around 90% of the electricity used in Hong Kong, and improving their energy efficiency is most crucial for carbon reduction. Retro-commissioning (RCx) is a systematic, cost-effective and innovative way to save energy. Businesses can optimise the energy efficiency of their premises and achieve their energy saving goals at a faster pace without needing full replacement of equipment.

The programme consist of of three phases: Pledge, Equip and Implementation, encouraging participating organisations to set energy saving goals and take part in professional training courses, so that energy management staff can understand the benefits of RCx and design suitable energy saving solutions with the support of CLP. Eligible RCx projects will be further subsidised by the CLP Eco Building Fund to help shorten the investment payback period.

Over 60 organisations have already signed up to take part taking part since its launch and will carry out RCx works for more than 100 buildings in the pipeline. An estimated 15 gigawatt hours (GWh) of electricity a year will be saved when the works are completed, equivalent to the annual energy consumption of around 3,400 CLP Power residential customers.
