Who is Eligible?

- Schools* or educational institutions#; or
- Non-profit-making organisations^, such as non-governmental organisations, green groups, and community organisations.

How to Apply?

Applicants should submit an application form, in which a brief description of the project, its objectives and target beneficiaries, along with details of how it will be implemented, a budget breakdown, and the expected outcome should be specified.

Powering a Smarter and Greener Tomorrow

The CLP Education Fund has been set up to promote energy efficiency and conservation (EE&C) by providing funding for projects related to EE&C education and promotion.

What Kind of Application will be Prioritised for Funding?

- The project is considered innovative in promoting EE&C;
- The applicant has not previously received funding from the CLP Education Fund; or
- The type of project has not previously received funding from the CLP Education Fund.

What are the Funding Limits?

- The maximum funding amount is HK\$100,000 or the total budget of the project, whichever is lower.

* The school must be registered under the Education Ordinance.

The educational institution must be registered or established under the applicable ordinance.

^ The organisation must provide relevant documentary evidence of its non-profit-making status, and be registered or established under the applicable ordinance.
